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SPEAKER

Juan Diego Noreña was born in Columbia as the youngest of 4 sons. After focusing on the impact of breastfeeding as a public health intervention, he graduated with a degree in Nutrition and Diet with an emphasis in Community Education. He arrived in the USA in 2000 and began volunteering at MOMS Orange County in 2001, eventually becoming part of the staff. Wanting to share with Latino fathers the importance of breastfeeding and how we can support our partners to be successful at breastfeeding, he created a program "Daddy Boot Camp," which is designed to prepare future dads and encourage them to be more active in the lives of their children and family. Currently, he is the Education Manager at MOMS, teaching prenatal classes and childbirth preparation, providing support in gestational diabetes, in addition to conducting the Daddy Boot Camp. He has two children, Valeria (16) and Santiago (14).

DESCRIPTION

Much has been said about the benefits of breast milk and how this practice strengthens the bond between mother and child, but within this process, where is dad? Although it is true that breastfeeding is a task that, for biological reasons, corresponds to the mother, the father also has an important role in this activity and his support is essential, both for the couple and for the baby.
